**RE: WANLESS REPORT**

I note with interest the contents of the Wanless Report published on the 11<sup>th</sup> of November 2014.

You will recall I wrote to you previously regarding Tim Hulbert. On reading the Wanless report I was struck by the lack of information pertaining to certain individuals that had been identified by Tim Hulbert as being in a position to be helpful to the review.

In the Wanless review page 29 paragraph 10, there is reference to three people identified by Hulbert but the report indicates that one cannot be traced, the other has not responded.

Given that at least one of the individuals in question was a civil servant, can you pursue him using internal channels? If he was indeed a civil servant the Home Office would retain pension payment details. Given the seriousness of the allegations, it's worth pursuing all possibilities.
