Re. P.I.E. - PAEDOPHILE INFORMATION EXCHANGE.

1.

Commander 'A' Department

1. This report deals with an investigation by this Force into an organisation known as the Paedophile Information Exchange.
2. This organisation consists of a group of men that advocate that sexual acts between adults and children should, with certain limited exceptions, be made legal and even in the event of such an act falling into their category of exceptions, then that act should be dealt with outside the criminal law and with the utmost leniency.
3. PIE declares that their interests do not only lie with the paedophile himself - or herself - but also in the interest of the child who, according to PIE, has its own sexuality and should be allowed to express it in a practical manner, namely to be allowed to engage in sexual acts of any nature as long as they themselves desire such experiences.
4. Since the birth of the organisation in October 1974, a number of persons have been involved in its organisation and management and the following are those principally involved:-

151. On the 2nd October 1978, Police Sergeant Collins and Police Constable Atkins interviewed HAYMAN at DPA London, W2, and searched these premises by virtue of a search warrant issued under the Obscene Publications Act and the Protection of Children Act. HAYMAN made a written statement under caution and this is shown as Exhibit No. EC/32.

152. HAYMAN's personal particulars and true identity were not known. He used the name Peter KEMBERSON and the address in W2., for his sexual activities. He states he joined PIE about a year ago and did so with a view to contacting others with whom he could correspond and fantasise sexually. His statement is short and of no great value, but he was aware at the time of interview that his true identity was not known to Police and that it was probable that it would remain unknown. He was in possession of a unique quantity of grossly obscene writings and photographs and sexual items, all relating to his own sexual activities. These

were contained in forty-five bound volumes which are a record of his sexual activities over the past seven years. As a result of joining PIE he then corresponded with a number of members and they, with HAYMAN, are the subject of a separate report to the Director of Public Prosecutions, (DPA refers), who has advised that HAYMAN be officially cautioned for sending indecent material through the post. This has been done.

153. HAYMAN corresponded with PIE in the person of David GROVE. Exhibit No. PH/1 is one of those letters. It states: "Dear Mr. Grove, Thank you for your very prompt and cautious reply to my letter. I am most impressed. I am eager to receive more information as you have promised, some information about other contacts too please and your next letter.

I have great affection for a little girl called WM-A117. Naturally we have seen each other naked. We have engaged in kissing and external caressing, but I have not dared to go further. I have also seen her stark naked with a little boy similarly nude. It is a wonderful and beautiful experience, but naturally my virile feelings are aroused and I long to go further. Can you give me some advice please?"

This letter is signed Peter HENDERSON.

154. On the letter has been written "New Member? Police Trap?" One more it can be seen from this letter that PIE are aware of a members sexual desires towards children, but this did not stop them assisting HAYMAN to contact others similarly minded.
155. HAYMAN's true identity was later established and he was seen again by Police at his home address. Despite the fact that he has the private address and telephone number of GROVE in his diary he was unable - or unwilling - to discuss his association with PIE any further.

His association with PIE enabled him to correspond with the members WM-F24, WM-F25, SEWELL and WARDELL, all dealt with in this report. All the correspondence between them is obscene. This has been exhibited in the separate report mentioned above and is not, at this time, reproduced in this report.
