



INDEPENDENT INQUIRY CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

CHANGE IN RECOGNISED LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE

1. On 28 April 2017, Nottinghamshire City Council ('the Council') was designated as a core participant in the Children in the Care of Nottinghamshire Councils investigation. At the same time, Sarah Molyneux, Head of Legal and Governance, was designated as the Council's recognised legal representative.
2. On 4 June 2019, the Inquiry was informed by Ms Molyneux that, as of 7 June 2019, she would no longer represent the Council. She requested that Malcolm Townroe, Director of Legal and Governance, be designated the Council's recognised legal representative in her place.
3. Accordingly, as I am satisfied that Mr Townroe has been appointed by the Council as its qualified lawyer, I designate Mr Townroe as the Council's recognised legal representative in this investigation in accordance with Rule 6(1) of the Inquiry Rules 2006 as I am required by that rule to do.
