ORDER

UPON a further directions meeting;

AND UPON hearing Mr Browne QC and Adam Speker for the close living relations of the late Bishop George Bell;

AND UPON hearing Mr William Chapman for the complainant known as [Name Redacted];

AND UPON hearing Ms Samantha Cohen for the Core Group;

AND UPON a direction by Mr Briden that evidence relating to the allegations made and the account given by [Name Redacted] shall not be admissible as similar fact evidence;

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- (1) [Name Redacted] legal representatives shall serve written submissions by 4 PM on 2 November 2018.
- (2) The legal representatives of the Core Group and the close living relations of the late Bishop George Bell have leave, if so advised, to serve written submissions by 4 PM on 7 November 2018.
- (3) Any submissions served in compliance with paragraphs (1) or (2) shall be served on all the parties listed in paragraph 1 of the order of 30 July 2018 and Mr Paul Stevenson.
- (4) Paragraphs 7, 8 and 9 of the order of 30 July 2018 are discharged.
