I have received an email response from **RC-A423** regarding the incidents involving Fr **RC-F46**. There are three incidents he can recall.

1 He was 13 years old when he was beaten up by pupils from another school when walking to the sports fields and had suffered several kicks to the groin area. He preorted to Fr **RC-F46** who took him to some changing rooms where he examined his private parts but didn't touch him.

2. When he was 12-14 years old he was travelling on an overnight train to **DPA** on a school trip. He was playing cards with some friends in an allocated compartment when Fr **RC-F46** told him to come to his compartment. He then sat him on his bed and proceeded to insist that he was masturbating with my friends on the top bunk. No touching took place and he was returned to his compartment.

3. The third instance was on arrival in **DPA** While he was in his allocated room and the order for lights out

been called, **RC-F46** insisted that he join him in his room where a similar scenario as the train journey played out. He insisted that he undress and get into his bed, but **RC-A423** refused and he was sent back to his room.

He states he is only considering action due to recent developments involving the church and school. He wants revenge and the possibility of cash.

I have also received an email from **RC-A423** in which he encloses a response from his solicitors stating they are unable to assist as he wasn't abused.

I have responded in the email to the effect that, on the face of what he was emailed no offences have taken place that could be investigated by CAIT.

I have read the updates from DS Morgan in light of the victims disclosure and on the information that has been provided, no crimes have been committed. The behaviour of the suspect is perhaps inappropriate and would breach safeguarding principles as they exist today, however in the absence of any physical contact between the 2 or any incitement, I maintain that no crimes have been committed in this case and would ask that the classification be amended accordingly.

I am aware that DS Morgan will be attending a further strategy in respect of this to discuss with the other professional what measures should be put in place to safeguard other young people.
