 Child's relationship to AAP: At The Time Maths Pupil

An allegation has been made to Metropolitan Police on 27/08/2010 from a RC-A604 who has made a historical allegation of sexual abuse against Mr Stephen Skelton who was a maths teacher at St Benedicts School, Ealing. (an independent boys school). He states that the offences took place in the summer of 1983. His parents had arranged extra maths lessons for him. He had to go to Skelton's home address every weekend to receive these lessons. Originally Skelton just put his arm around him and played with his hair on the first occasion. The 2nd occasion he gave him a large bag of candy bars. He states Skelton alternated between putting his arms around him and then he would sit him on his lap. He said that Skelton would stroke his hair and ask him questions like where he got his clothes, haircuts etc. Victim stated he felt a bit nervous about all of this and felt that something was wrong. On the third weekend, which was his final lesson, he states he felt very apprehensive about going to the appointment. Before going into his home he stated that he had already prepared an excuse so
