

Reshet Safeguarding Survey Findings

Executive summary: 64 respondents from 45 organisations (both London, regional and national) completed the survey. Whilst some have accessed safeguarding training there is a clear remit for Reshet to provide signposting and support in this area of work. Training on safeguarding, child protection and risk assessment have received the most interest but policy development implementation have been requested.
