During an interview with Sylvia Medhurst (ex Assistant Director) she recalled her role as Chair of the disciplinary relating to [LA-F4] in 1989.

Sylvia stated that following the hearing she discussed with David Pope her concerns about John Carroll's role in this case. She felt that as Officer in Charge of Angell Road he must have known that something irregular was happening between [LA-F4] and the victim, a resident of Angell Road. She reported that David Pope's response was that he needed proof to indicate this.

In light of the fact that David Pope had been aware since 1986 that John Carroll was a Schedule 1 offender (he chaired the disciplinary regarding this issue) his response to Sylvia's expressed concerns appears inadequate and potentially negligent.
