You are probably aware of recent events concerning LA-A23 and that LA-F36 is offering him a permanent home. We understand that LA-F36 has asked you for a reference, and we now would like to have this urgently. To complicate matters we have just heard, via DPA and an unnamed ex-member of your staff team at DPA that LA-F36's time with DPA was by no means straight forward and that there are real grounds to be worried about his future contact with LA-A23

I would be grateful if you would comment on this and give us any other relevant information as soon as possible. At present LA-A23 is staying with LA-F36 and we are committed to assessing the possibility of this being made a permanent arrangement.

Could you please be as detailed and explicit as you can and include the following:-

1. For how long did you know LA-F36, how well as a person, and in what capacity.
2. Your opinions as to his suitability as a foster-parent
3. Your opinion concerning his motivation
4. The quality of his relationship with LA-A23
5. Any incidents that caused you concern with LA-A23 or other children or staff.
