

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

CHANGE IN RECOGNISED LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE

1. On 24 March 2016, JA-A6/B9, JA-A7/B10 and Mr Anthony Hyde were designated as core participants in the Inquiry's investigation into the institutional responses to allegations of child sexual abuse involving the late Lord Janner of Braunstone QC. At the same time, Deborah Corcoran of QualitySolicitors Abney Garsden (now Simpson Millar) was recognised as their legal representative.
2. On 6 August 2020, the Inquiry was formally notified that Ms Corcoran no longer worked at Simpson Millar and that Ms Nathalie Swanwick would be acting as JA-A6/B9, JA-A7/B10 and Mr Anthony Hyde's legal representative in relation to this investigation.
3. Accordingly, as I am satisfied that JA-A6/B9, JA-A7/B10 and Mr Anthony Hyde have now appointed Ms Swanwick as their qualified lawyer, I designate Ms Swanwick of Simpson Millar as their recognised legal representative in this investigation in accordance with Rule 6(1) of the Inquiry Rules 2006 as I am required by that rule to do.
