

Referral summary

Please summarise the reason for this referral:

CS-A29 is a vulnerable young person of 13 years old. Both of **CS-A29**'s parent's struggle to manage her behaviour and state this has been an on-going issue since **CS-A29** was in primary school.

CS-A29 has been living with her Father for over a year due to the relationship between **CS-A29** and her Mother breaking down.

CS-A29 is associating with older people who are mostly male and has been staying out late and not returning at an appropriate time. **CS-A29** has admitted to the previous social worker that she regularly drinks alcohol when out with friends, this is of concern as research has shown that young people who drink on the streets can be the target of perpetrators of CSE. In addition to this she has been reported missing by the police on one occasion and placed herself in danger.

CS-A29 has a diagnosis of ADHD and although she takes medication for this she appears to act with some impulsivity at times despite recognising that she is placing herself in danger.

CS-A29 has also been sexually active with an older young person of 16 years.

In addition to this **CS-A29** has admitted to stealing money to buy Cannabis and is reported to have used this in a flat with older men.

There has been a further report from the police dated 07/08/16 that **CS-A29**'s friend reported that **CS-A29** sexual relations with a known offender in July 2016. This has not yet been substantiated, investigations are ongoing.

CS-A29 appears to be a young person who is clearly placing herself at risk of CSE and requires intensive support to ensure that she does not place herself in any further risk taking activity.
