Will look to invite Brian Russell from Durham Agency Against Crime to the next meeting to provide an overview of their initiatives and work with young people.</p> <p>Chair suggested we need to consider the SEND cohort and how we can engage with them and also those children who have been permanently excluded. In other areas of the country, it is this cohort of young people who have been excluded that are more likely to be targeted.
