

Chantal, Anna, the police and the local authority are worried that CS-A24 will often go out and will not return home when she should. We are worried because CS-A24's mum does not always know where CS-A24 is or who she is with and when she goes missing mum doesn't always report her as missing to the police. If CS-A24 doesn't return home and mum doesn't tell people she is missing, CS-A24 could be hurt and nobody would know. If this happens CS-A24 could be left for a long time without any help from anyone and she could be seriously hurt. She could also be very scared if she is in a dangerous situation and nobody knows.

### **Danger Statement 2 – Child Sexual Exploitation**

Chantal, Ann, the police and the local authority are worried because CS-A24 has been spending time with older people and other young people who social services consider to be at risk of being sexually exploited and taken advantage of by other people. We are worried because mum told the police that CS-A24 had told her that she had been 'with Romanian men and the fact that she would disappear and that neither police nor social services would find her'. We are worried that older people could take advantage of CS-A24 by grooming her. They could give CS-A24 money, drugs and alcohol and ask for sex from her in return. If this was to happen CS-A24 could feel frighten and scared, we are worried that she could be controlled by older men or women and that she could end up with a serious infection or seriously hurt.

### **Danger Statement 3 – Drugs**

Chantal, Anna and the Local authority are worried that CS-A24's mother and CS-A24 has told us on the 28<sup>th</sup> June 2018 that she is smoking cannabis took ketamine on the 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2018, took amphetamine on the weekend of the 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2018 and took Valium on the 27<sup>th</sup> June 2018. We are worried that CS-A24's drug use is getting worse and that she is very impulsive and will take drugs even if she is unsure of what they are. We are worried because mum tells us that she does not give CS-A24 any money in her hand and so does not know how she is paying for these drugs. We are worried that if CS-A24 was to continue taking drugs she could over dose accidentally or could end up seriously ill or even dead. We are worried that if CS-A24 is under the influence of drugs she could be taken advantage of sexual or physically. We are worried that if CS-A24 was to take a drug and she did not know what it was in could make her behave in an unusual or dangerous way where she could get hurt or be at risk.

### **Danger statement 3 – Violent behaviour**

Chantal, Anna and the local authority are worried that mum has told professionals that she is scared of CS-A24. We are worried that CS-A24 has threatened to stab mum with a knife and has thrown stones and bricks at a male's property smashing his window. We are worried that if this behaviour continues CS-A24 will be at risk of seriously hurting someone or killing them and having a criminal record. We are worried that this has happened in front of CS-A24's younger brother and sister and that this would have made them very scared and frightened and that they could also have been seriously hurt.

### **Danger statement 4 - Boundaries and routines**

Anna, Chantal and the local authority are worried that mum has said she is frightened of CS-A24 and that she struggles to put consistent boundaries and routines in place for CS-A24 as she is worried about how CS-A24 will react to this. We are worried that and this may prevent her putting in safe strategies to keep CS-A24 safe. We are worried that if CS-A24's brother and sister are seeing CS-A24 getting away with this behaviour than they may think that they can behave like that to. If mum is not able to put routines and boundaries in place for CS-A24 may continue to make unsafe decisions that place herself, her mum, her brother and sister and others at risk of harm.
