We are worried that CS-A221 has been staying at the home of a registered sex offender for a long period of time and that parents knew this adult male had previously been to prison. We know that CS-A221 and parents were getting presents from this adult male but did not recognise that they were being groomed.

We are worried about Mum's decision making regarding risky people and that recently she talked about allowing a friend to visit the home despite having been advised not to.

<p>Social Worker:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Worries that [CS-A221] had been spending lots of time with family friend CS-F237 and has stayed overnight at his home. CS-F237 said that they both slept on sofa's but later in bed. • We know that CS-F237 is a registered sex offender. • Gran disclosed at Conference that she had worries about [CS-F237] last year, but she did not share her worries with anyone else. • Parents discovered that CS-F237 was a sex offender but chose not to share this with the social worker. • Social worker did not complete checks on CS-F237 as she was not aware of the concerns and was led to understand that [CS-F237] was a vulnerable adult. • Parents had been going back and forth to CS-F237 home and CS-F237 had visited their home, Parents have said they felt that [CS-F237] behaviour towards [CS-A221] was suspicious. • Parents say that they attended court this week and CS-F237 showed no remorse for his actions at Court last week. • [CS-A221] has not made any disclosures of sexual abuse or grooming. • Following the court hearing [CS-A221] says that he hates that CS-F237 has 'done this' to other people. 	<p>Social Worker</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When [CS-A221] makes phone calls, they will be on loud speaker so that parents can overhear his conversations. • When the mobile phone is returned, the SIM card will need to be replaced so that CS-F237 is not able to contact [CS-A221] • Social worker says that [CS-A221] engaged well in the sexual exploitation work. • Social worker says that [CS-A221] likes outdoor activities and should be easy to engage. <p>Police</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CS-F237 appeared at Court last week and receive a 24 month custodial sentence for breach of a SHPO as a result of his contact with [CS-A221] • Police have confiscated the phone bought for [CS-A221] by [CS-F237] <p>Support:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • [CS-A221] has been referred to FIT for CSE prevention work. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social worker has contacted Stop it Now for support for parents. • Parents have completed the Equilibrium programme.
