Examples of contextual practice identified....

- Following a suicide a separate strategy meeting was set up by Evolve to map the young people connected to that young person and who may be concerned or affected by it. This allowed practitioners to put in supportive, preventative services straight away.
- Following concerns about the use of a bunker by young people where there were concerns about extra-familial harm Kelly went to the planning office to try and locate find pre WW2 bunker plans in a bid to identify its location
- Practitioners are starting to hold planning/mapping meetings to consider peer groups/ locations. There have been some good examples identified during the mapping process of work between YOS, Kelly, and housing colleagues to identify and develop responses to concerns regarding peer relationships and specific locations
