

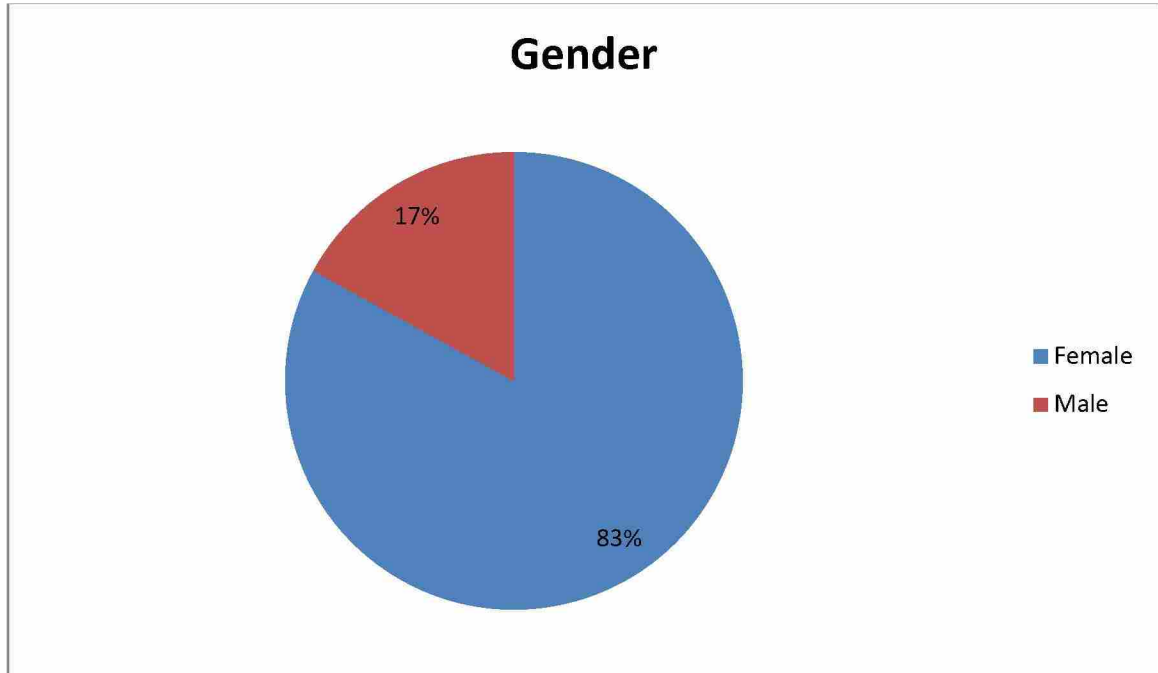


Children At Risk Of Child Sexual Exploitation In Bristol

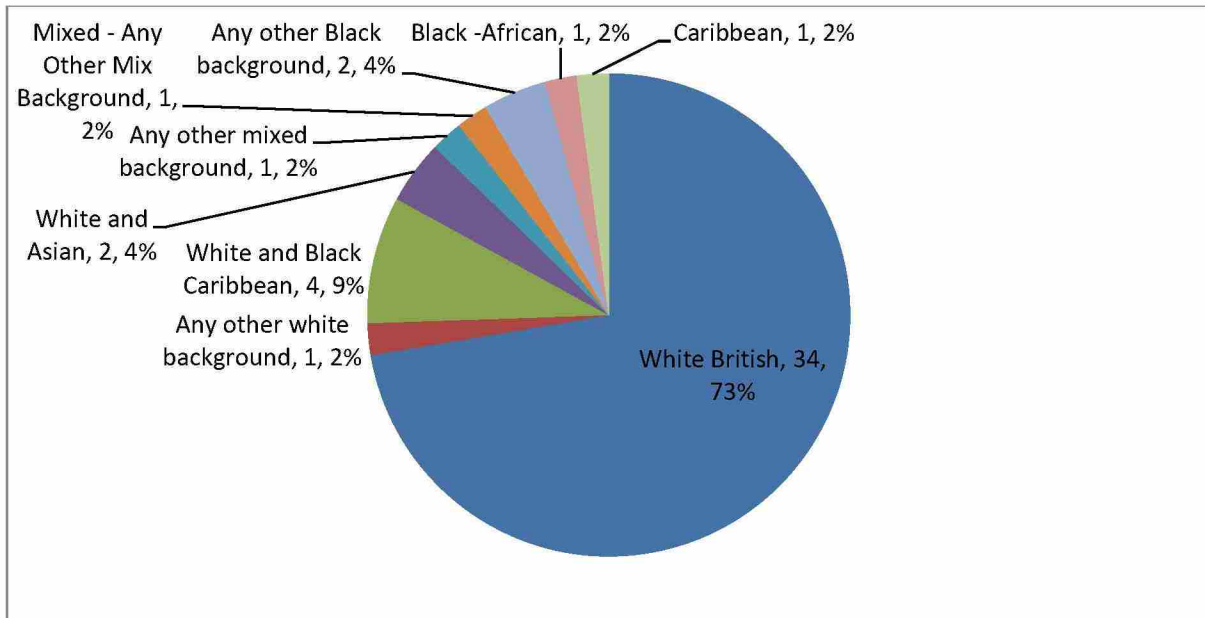


Children And Families



This chart shows the gender of children with an open referral to Children and Families Services where there is a CSE flag on their record at present. This shows that females are 4 times more likely than males to be identified as at risk of CSE. This is broadly in line with the recognition of boys over the previous two years.

4. Ethnicity



Around 27% of children in the current cohort are from Black and ethnic minority backgrounds. This is slightly lower than the demographics for children in Bristol which is 28% of children in the whole population are from Black and ethnic minority backgrounds. This profile shows a slight reduction in
