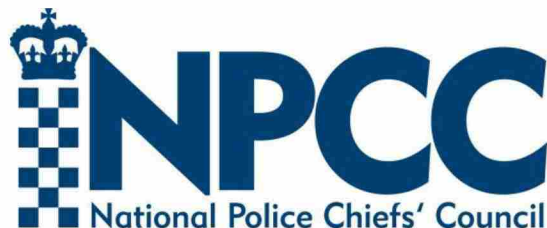

National Vulnerability Action Plan

At the July meeting of Chief Constables' Council, the National Vulnerability Action Plan (NVAP) was circulated as a regional paper to all forces. CC Simon Bailey has addressed the outstanding queries from the council meeting and consequently, we are able to confirm that all 43 forces of England and Wales now support the National Vulnerability Action Plan and it has been formally adopted by the service.

Please see the latest iteration of the plan for your information and action. DCC Manners, under the direction of the National Crime Operations Coordination Committee and the Violence and Public Protection Portfolio, and in collaboration with other national leads, is to work on removing actions from linked existing national action plans to start reducing the pressure that these plans and actions place on forces.

We now seek your support in working to achieve the key deliverables within the National Vulnerability Action Plan and DCC Manners' office will share relevant guidance and support those wishing to create their own delivery plans.
