

**Inquiries Act 2005**

**Restriction Order Pursuant to Section 19**

**Child Sexual Exploitation by Organised Networks Investigation Public Hearing**

1. During Day 1 of the Child Sexual Exploitation by Organised Networks investigation hearing on 21 September 2020 opening statements were made by a number of core participant team legal representatives including:
  - (a) Kim Harrison on behalf of CS-A2;
  - (b) Samantha Leek on behalf of Warwickshire County Council.
2. During the opening statements referred to at paragraphs 1 (a) and 1 (b) above Ms Harrison and Ms Leek referred to information relating to CS-A1's family history which CS-A2 considers may be capable of identifying CS-A1.
3. The information referred to at paragraph 2 will be removed from both the recording and the transcript of Day 1 of the public hearing before they are published in order to protect the identity of CS-A1.
4. Additionally, the Chair considers it necessary to put in place this Restriction Order to prohibit anyone from disclosing, publishing or making public the information about CS-A1's family history which may be capable of leading to their identification.

**Restriction Order**

5. This Restriction Order is made under section 19(1) of the Inquiries Act 2005 ("the Act") and binds all members of the public, including Core Participants.
6. This Restriction Order prohibits disclosure and/or publication of the information referred to at paragraph 2 above or any information capable of leading members of

the public to identify CS-A1 in connection with the Inquiry's investigations.

7. For the avoidance of doubt, publication includes publishing information on any website, blog, Twitter or other social media.
8. In the case of public authorities, the restrictions specified in this Order take effect subject to the terms of section 20(6) of the Inquiries Act 2005.
9. Pursuant to section 20(4) of the Inquiries Act 2005 the Chair may vary or revoke this Restriction Order by making a further order during the course of the Inquiry.
10. Any person affected by this Order may apply in accordance with section 20 of the Inquiries Act 2005 to vary its terms.
11. This Restriction Order continues in force indefinitely, or unless the order is varied or revoked pursuant to section 20 of the Inquiries Act 2005.
