

Welsh Government - National Action Plan on Preventing and Responding to Child Sexual Abuse

Arrangements for implementation by Safeguarding Children's Boards

February 2020

The Plan was published on 15 July 2019 and is set out against three reporting periods. The first reporting period covers 31 July 2019- 31 December 2019.

For Period 1 Safeguarding Children Boards were required to evidence that they had put in place measures to ensure that partners are aware of the actions contained in the Plan and had agreed arrangements for evidencing the implementation of actions within the Plan in Period 2 and Period 3. Safeguarding Children Boards were required to provide this evidence by 31 January 2020.

Each of the 6 Safeguarding Children Boards has submitted this evidence and confirmed that awareness of the Plan and actions have been considered via the Safeguarding Children Board with members.

Safeguarding Children Boards	Measures taken to support implementation
Cardiff and the Vale	Regional implementation plan submitted. Actions assigned to relevant sub-groups /working groups and working plans of the Board.
Cwm Taf Morganwng	Regional implementation plan submitted. Actions assigned to relevant sub-groups /working groups and working plans of the Board and relevant regional groups such as for example the region MACSE.
CYSUR /Mid and West	Regional implementation plan submitted. Multi-agency regional Task and Finish Group to identify strategies to meet the requirements of the plan has been established.

Gwent	<p>Regional implementation plan submitted.</p> <p>Board's Business Planning Group has commissioned a Task and Finish Group to make arrangements to comply with the objectives and actions set out within the National Action Plan for Preventing and Responding to Child Sexual Abuse.</p> <p>In order to robustly monitor the implementation of the action plan, this regional work is being overseen and monitored by the Gwent Safeguarding Board's Business Planning Group.</p>
North Wales	<p>Regional implementation plan submitted.</p> <p>Actions assigned to relevant sub-groups /working groups and working plans of the Board.</p> <p>The North Wales Safeguarding Board have done CSA action plan awareness raising presentations to each Local Delivery Group in North Wales during 2019. It will be the responsibility of the Local Delivery Group to raise awareness in its locality area. The Local delivery group will then report back to the North Wales Safeguarding Children Board on a quarterly basis.</p>
West Glamorgan	<p>Regional implementation plan submitted.</p> <p>The Board held a National Action Plan CSA awareness session as part of the last Quality, Performance & Practice Management Group meeting. This group will be responsible for the delivery of the action plan and report back to the Safeguarding Board on a quarterly basis.</p>
