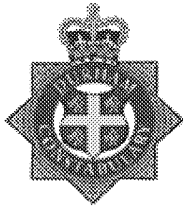

 On the 02/02/2017 care staff at Children's Home 86 reported that CS-A434 DPA /2003 and CS-A29 DPA /2002 both left the home that morning at 10:10hrs without permission in company with CS-B1374 DPA /2002.
 CS-A29 DPA and CS-A434 DPA /2003 were returned to the home less than 12 hrs prior and CS-A29 was believed to be under the influence of drugs at the time of her return CS-A29 has been missing 7 times in the last 5 days and is classed as at high risk of CSE due to her previous actions.
 They were both located at DPA home of CS-B1374 DPA /2002 where they were playing xbox in CS-B1374 bedroom. Due to the circumstances at 14:43 Insp DPA McCarthy authorised CS-A29 being taken into police protection in the hope that more effective safeguards could be placed around a high risk vulnerable child.
 CS-A434 was taken back to Children's Home 86 where he will discuss his options with his social worker. It appears that CS-A29 CS-A434 and another resident CS-B11 are negatively influencing each other and their friendship is of growing concern.
 Update CS-A29 was taken back Children's Home 86 and handed over to Emma PHELPS who is CS-A29 Social Worker. Emma stated it would be either herself or Senior Social worker Mairi PRATT-WHITE who would chair the planning strategy meeting tomorrow. Mairi can be contacted on DPA if required.
