

14. In matters touching the fostering and/or adoption of migrant children, the custodian authority should indicate its attitude towards the proposition and in the cases wherein both custodian and guardian agree the child will be placed accordingly.

In the event of disagreement, custodian and guardian shall confer with a view to arriving at a mutually satisfactory decision. If this is not achieved and the guardian is satisfied that the child's best interests will be promoted by placement in a private home, he takes full responsibility for the decision to so place the child.

In all matters touching the disposition of any child, the child's future well-being will be the paramount consideration in arriving at a decision respecting such child.

15. Regular conferences to be held between officers of this Department and the separate custodian authorities for the purpose of solving minor problems which may arise from time to time.
