CHRISTIAN BROTHERS' INSTITUTIONS - WESTERN AUSTRALIA.

CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS - TARDUN TRAINING SCHOOL.

AN AGREEMENT made the twenty-fourth day of April
nineteen hundred and thirty-nine between HIS MAJESTY'S
SECRETARY OF STATE FOR DOMINION AFFAIRS (hereinafter called
"the Secretary of State") of the one part and the
CHRISTIAN BROTHERS OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA (hereinafter called
"the Brothers") of the other part.

WHEREAS under the Empire Settlement Acts 1922 and
1937 the Secretary of State may co-operate with private
organisations in formulating and carrying out schemes for
affording joint assistance to persons who intend to settle
in any part of His Majesty's Overseas Dominions

AND WHEREAS the Brothers have established an
Agricultural Training School at Tardun in the State of
Western Australia (hereinafter called "the Training School")
and are now engaged in the extension of the Training School
so as to provide inter alia accommodation for the training
of children from the United Kingdom for settlement in
AUSTRALIA at a total estimated cost (including the value of
the voluntary labour of the Brothers) of twenty thousand
pounds Australian (hereinafter called "the said scheme")

AND WHEREAS the Secretary of State is prepared to
contribute towards such part of the said scheme
(hereinafter referred to as "the approved portion of the
said scheme") as may be regarded as directly ancillary to
the training of migrant children
