In C.R.O. envelopes (no envelope available, double envelopes label to be Economy **CLOSED UNTIL 1989** is not double Secret envelope. ble.

In safes or security cupboards.

SECRET

In C.R.O. envelopes (no envelope required). If a box is not available, double envelopes; or single envelope marked "Secret" if taken direct by hand. Economy labels may be used if envelopes in good condition.

In safes, or security cupboards, or steel pull-out drawer cabinets strengthened with locking bar.

CONFIDENTIAL

In pouches or single envelopes marked "Confidential". Economy labels may be used if envelopes in good condition.

In ordinary steel cupboards or steel pull-out drawer cabinets.
