CS-A1 had a boyfriend named CS-B820 for a short period of time in January 2019; CS-A1 reported he was 15 and lived in DPA but from Warwickshire Area, believed to have met at a party.

Recently CS-A1 has discussed CS-F129 from DPA, this is believed to be CS-F129 known to police and recently released from young offenders institute.

### 5.10 What protective factors exist or could be developed in the child's locality and wider community?

CS-A1 has engaged extremely well with education, attending daily and achieving well. She has built up positive relationships with staff members at school.

CS-A1 also has positive relationships with staff in Children's Home 9 and on several occasions has been able to open up and speak about how she is feeling.

### 5.11 What do you need to know more about?

Whom CS-A1 is spending free time and associating with.

Whom CS-A1 has been collected in a car by.

Addresses where CS-A1 has stayed overnight without permission.

## 6. Child/Young Person and Parent/Carer views

### 6.1 What are the child's views about their needs and the risks they face?

CS-A1 shared with Social Worker that she feels she has a label of CSE. CS-A1 shared that she is no longer associating with the males that she previously spoke with and she has moved away from these groups.

CS-A1 shared that she is open to undertaking CSE work with her Barnado's worker.

### 6.2 What do they want for the short and longer term future?

CS-A1 wishes to have social media on her phone and reduce the restrictions around this.

CS-A1 wants to work towards her independence and have more flexible free time.

CS-A1 shared that she would like to secure a job to earn her own money, she is not entirely sure what line of work she wants to go into but is considering hair and beauty/working with children.

### 6.3 What are the parent(s)/carer(s) views about the child's needs and the risks they face?

Parents reports she feels Children's Home 9 have supported CS-A1 to make significant progress over the last nine months. However, Mrs CS-A2 feels that the level of risk in respect of exploitation remains high due to the fact that CS-A1 continues to go missing and on some occasions this is overnight. In addition to this Mrs CS-A2 reports that CS-A1 during these times misuses alcohol and illicit substances which increases risk.

### 6.4 What do they want for the child's short and long term future?

Both Parents wish for CS-A1 to be happy, safe and achieve. They wish for CS-A1 to access work in respect of CSE and also therapeutic support in the short term so that in long term she has developed necessary skills to promote her emotional well being and to keep herself safe.

Parents want CS-A1 to live independently as an adult safely.
