1/19	Concerns in accuracy of data recording in CSE (both officers identifying the offending but also the use of markers); (a) Forces to come back and share process of data recording in CSE specifically, and confidence levels of accuracy (b) To include the issue of data recording for vulnerability in the discovery day and to identify how to pull data back at ROCU. May be useful for Force Crime Registrars to come together	5/3/2020: Main feedback from forces is that because CSE is a flag which has to be applied, there is a high error rate which is currently rectified by training, which has resourcing implications as new staff arrive but the appetite around data quality is low compared to other issues. ACTION: A regional workshop to be organised with force practitioners to take learning and inform best practice and solutions.	ROCUWM

There is a concern about the current practice that the force who owns the investigation is the force where the offence happens and not of the offenders home location. Whilst the data is aggregated by the region it isn't circulated back into the forces, although they will be aware at an investigation level. ACTION: To circulate OCAG database on a monthly basis to all Forces. Also to share any profiles on OCAGs which are produced with local forces and ROCUWM to speak with the national lead to get the national profiles.	ROCUWM
