

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

CHANGE IN RECOGNISED LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE

1. On 29 February and 20 May 2016 the Chair granted applications for core participant status to A26, A27, A28, A29, A30, A31, A32, A33, A34, A36, A37, A38, A39, A41 and A42 in relation to the investigation into the institutional responses to allegations of child sexual abuse involving the late Lord Janner of Braunstone QC. The Chair designated Liz Dux of Slater and Gordon solicitors as the recognised legal representative for those individuals.
2. On 21 September 2016, the Inquiry was informed that Ms Dux was leaving her current role at Slater and Gordon solicitors and that Richard Scorer would be replacing her as legal representative of the above complainant core participants. The Inquiry was subsequently informed on 28 April 2017 that Kim Harrison was now acting as legal representative in respect of the above complainant core participants in this investigation.
3. Accordingly, as I am satisfied that the complainant core participants concerned have now appointed Kim Harrison of Slater and Gordon solicitors as their qualified lawyer, I designate Kim Harrison as their recognised legal representative in this investigation in accordance with rule 6(1) as I am required by that rule to do.
