

NOTES ON MEETING, RE: ANGELL ROAD ALLEGATIONS

J. Durrant made the introductions. The purpose of the meeting was explained, i.e. to give ~~the~~ the opportunity to raise any questions/points he may have and also to discuss events which had occurred following the suspension.

LA-F4 was asked if he made a statement. He asked why, and it was explained that when a serious allegation was made the member of staff involved normally made a statement giving their version of events. LA-F4 said we had spoken to Reg, D. Instrell on the Wednesday and on Thursday had been officially suspended by R. Morton, D. Instrell and R. Rowe. He had not made any other statement.

J. Durrant stated the reason for the suspension, i.e. that a child at Angell Road had seen LA-F4 kissing and touching Sensitive/Irrelevant inappropriately. This was misconduct. Since then, steps had been taken to gather information to assist management to come to a decision about whether there was a case to answer or not.

LA-F4 said it seemed so to him.

J. Durrant replied, it would seem so to LA-F4 however management had received a number of statements and allegations from youngsters concerning the original child and also a separate allegation regarding 2 other children in Council care. The allegations were very serious and had not come from 1 child or were connected.
