Social Worker	<p>A Multi Agency Strategy was held on 23 August 2019 due to concerns that {CS-A114} was reported missing on Saturday night by {Name Redacted}. {CS-A114} was due to return home by 10:30 pm and when she did not, {Name Redacted} called the police.</p> <p>{CS-A114} returned home but went back out again. {CS-A114} went to {CS-F431} (a 19 year old male) home and stayed there until the police called at the address and took her home. {CS-A114} then became distressed. Sensitive/Irrelevant {CS-A114} began to feel ill and called the ambulance.</p> <p>Sensitive/Irrelevant</p>

The original referral was in relation to [CS-A114] pregnancy and termination.</p> <p>The outcome of the Strategy Meeting was s. 47 enquiry. The outcome of the Sec 47 was to proceed to ICPC.</p> <p>I am concerned that last Friday 6 Sept I visited [CS-A114] at [DPA] house and [CS-A114] had a black eye. [CS-A114] refused to tell me how she has received the black eye.</p>
