Police	Shared within the meeting
Social Worker	Increasingly worried about CS-A114 overall emotional well-being. CS-A114 appears to be increasingly making unwise and dangerous decisions. This has been demonstrated by CS-A114 recent offending behaviour. CS-A114 was detained overnight at DPA Police Station in connection to the theft of CS-A114 relative's car. CS-A114 also appears to be going from partner to partner and is currently in an unsuitable relationship with CS-A112.

	<p>In an attempt to safeguard [CS-A114] a CAWN notice has been served to [CS-A114]. The concern is that [CS-A114] is still in a relationship with [CS-A114] and having sex.</p> <p>[CS-A114] Mother and [Relative] have shown me text messages from [CS-A114] to another female that suggest [CS-A114] has been attempting to buy drugs/pills.</p> <p>[CS-A114] was seen on 15/10/2019 at home with her mum and she looked well presented. [CS-A114] missing episodes have decreased however she is still not engaging with education.</p> <p>[CS-A114] has been avoiding social worker and ERASE worker, however appointments have been made to see her.</p> <p>The local authority are looking at funding a [DPA] placement with dad in [DPA]. Mum, Dad and [CS-A114] are happy with the decision. Hopefully the [DPA] will happen before Christmas.</p>
