



Child Sexual Exploitation Risk Assessment Information Form

This child sexual exploitation (CSE) risk assessment information sheet should be completed prior to, and alongside the Child Sexual Exploitation Risk Assessment. **All** of the following information is required when there are concerns regarding a child being at risk of /or experiencing CSE.

CS-A114 has had previous involvement with Families First due to a pregnancy at the age of 13, she did have a termination in November 2018. **CS-A114** was referred back into Families First due to frequent missing episodes from school/home and when police located her she was found with love bites on her neck but wouldn't provide details on who had given them. **CS-A114** has recently gone missing from home and admitted to walking the streets all night and spending time with a 28 year old female but again no name was given.

No risk identified	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No concerns identified in this area which relate to sexual exploitation, is not sexually active and is aware of where to get support and advice when needed. 	
Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Young person is sexually active and in an equal consensual relationship with a peer. Young person does not feel pressured, they feel they can say 'no' and is following 'safe sex' advice. Possible evidence of having or had a sexually transmitted disease. 	
Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recurring or more than one sexually transmitted disease. Miscarriage(s) or concerns about untreated STIs, termination(s), pregnancy. Young person is sexually active, is not practising safe sex and is not accessing or willing to access support from any sexual health services. 	
High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recurring or multiple STIs. Concerns about untreated STIs Miscarriage(s), termination(s), pregnancy. Physical symptoms suggestive of sexual assault. Young person presents as feeling pressured to have sex or to perform sexual acts in exchange for status or protection, possessions, substances or affection. Young person is in a sexual relationship with an adult or there is a wide age gap. Young person is under 13 and sexually active. Sex is non-consensual – young person is experiencing violence or coercion with sex, or are unable to consent due to intoxication or substance misuse. Young person is made to watch sexual acts being performed on others. 	X
PROVIDE EVIDENCE OF CSE	<p>CS-A114 was pregnant, just after turning 13 so likely became pregnant at 12 - she had a termination in 2018.</p> <p>CS-A114 has also been seen with lots of love bites on her neck but wouldn't provide explanation about these.</p>

Views of the child or young person

CS-A114 had a termination, back in November 2018, however wasn't disclosing who the father was until recently when she gave a name to the PCSO Beth Maddox (13.02.19). CS-A114 is also disclosing that she isn't engaging in sexual activity since the 1st time however CS-A114 has been seen by police with "love bites" on her neck and again wouldn't disclose who these were from or who her boyfriend was.
