**CS-A27**

Concerns were around [CS-A27] having sexual contact with unknown adults.

The last review was cancelled due to social worker availability.

DC Passey reported [CS-A27] is a bit of a concern, during his debrief with [CS-A27] he stated it was a little uncomfortable. [CS-A27] has learning difficulties and has been diagnosed with [DPA] [DPA] moderate learning difficulties and ADHD traits and can present with difficult and challenging behaviours. It was said [CS-A27] presents as a 7 year old and it is felt he is very vulnerable. DC Passey reported [CS-A27] has a very strange outlook on life and has openly stated he enjoys having sex with strangers.

[CS-A27] is open to YPDAAT, however, he will not engage. [CS-A27] [Sensitive/irrelevant] [Sensitive/irrelevant] convicted of [Sensitive/irrelevant]

[CS-A27] is also refusing to engage with Catch 22.

[Children's Home 66] have reportedly stated they are aware of [CS-A27]'s whereabouts.
