

where possible re reasons why they went missing: where to; who with; how did they get there (train, bus, car); what they did/activity whilst missing; did you feel safe; names; descriptions; vehicles; addresses; locations; associates; friends (existing/new) telephone numbers; how did you get back home; did they return themselves? What made you come back; who returned them home? Are they afraid of anybody? has anything happened lately for you to go missing; are you worried about anything or anyone; frightened of anyone; has anyone hurt you; who would you talk to if you were worried about something etc. This should reflect the child's voice.

Safety: What might have made them safer when they were missing? Did they feel safe and looked after? Any concern regarding assault/abuse, threats to harm them? What happened when the child got home? What does the young person want to happen now - short term/long term? Are there any wider vulnerabilities/risks that present: For example - Mental Health, learning

Sensitive/Irrelevant

I asked CS-A1 where she stayed when she was missing and she said I'm not saying. CS-A1 said that she spent her weekend smoking weed she did some 'Coke' I asked if she stayed with her drug dealer friends. CS-A1 laughed and said no they live with their parents they wouldn't let me stay. I asked if their parents knew they sold drugs and she laughed again and said they grow it. CS-A1 said that she is now 'running drugs' I asked CS-A1 what she meant? CS-A1 said that she takes the drugs for her friends. CS-A1 said she delivers the drugs and has half the money. CS-A1 said that she did some deliveries at the weekend. I asked how much did she run CS-A1 said that she ran £120 of weed. I asked what she made and she looked puzzled and said 'whats half of £120? I explained to CS-A1 that her friend doesn't run the drugs himself incase he gets caught. I explained that if she gets caught she will be charged with drug dealing. CS-A1 shrugged and said I dont care. I asked CS-A1 what she wants the money for and she replied drugs I bought some Coke at the weekend. It made me feel better... 'snortng' the coke made my nose better. CS-A1 said that she is doing it because her friend has about 10 runners and he needs more runners. CS-A1 said she is happy to do it and will continue to. CS-A1 said they need more runners because they sell lots of drugs. CS-A1 said that she didn't deliver drugs on Sunday they sat in the cellar and smoked weed. CS-A1 said that she smokes weed every day she likes the room spinning and then relaxing. CS-A1 said she has a 'bong and a grinder' I asked where she keeps them and she said I'm not saying. CS-A1 said 'Oh no I can't believe I told you. I said you know I will share what you've said and CS-A1 said yeh that's fine. CS-A1 went back to class.

CS-A1 said she always feel safe the people she is with are her friends and they look after her.
 CS-A1 said she was a little scared 'running drugs' but it was Ok and exciting.
 CS-A1 said she isn't worried about getting into trouble with the Police.
