

INDEPENDENT INQUIRY - CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE

FINANCIAL REPORT – as at 31 December 2021 (Full Year – 2021-22)

1. OVERVIEW

The information in this report sets out the second quarter's position of expenditure for the 2021-22 financial year up to 31 December 2021, with a further breakdown of costs in relation to staffing and expenses. The expenditure for the full year ending 31 December 2021 is £10,338,628.
