Action Taken:

The following were informed and advice noted:

1. The psychiatrist who is currently seeing [Redacted]
2. The AEO Special Needs
3. NSPCC
4. Social Services
5. Chairman of School Governors
6. Educational Psychiatrist attached to school

Both sets of parents were visited by Mr Digan on 11th April 1989 and informed that we believe that incidents occurred. At this stage all the parents expressed confidence in the school's handling of the situation and wish to be supportive.

We are about to rearrange the grouping of boys within the sleeping areas so that [Redacted] will not in future be in the same room as [Redacted] and so that [Redacted] will be close to larger, more senior boys.

On Monday 17th April 1989 I told [Redacted] that I and other staff believed that sexual incidents had occurred and that we would make arrangements in school to avoid a recurrence. He continued to deny everything as expected. Shortly following this [Redacted] complained to me that he had been threatened by [Redacted]. Consequently [Redacted] has been told that I have made efforts to contain the problem within school but that should he attack [Redacted] or even persist in threats, outside agencies (eg Police) may have to become involved.
