

Mrs. Mellor stated that it was apparent that unacceptable behaviour among pupils appeared to have been tolerated or condoned by some staff over a long period of time.

Mr. Edmonds confirmed that Mr. Flammer, as School Psychologist, had been a regular visitor to the School for half a day a week at the material time though later vacancies in the service necessitated that individual Educational Psychologists dealt with individual pupils.

Mrs. Mellor enquired how should the interviews with the two pupils mentioned be set up.

Mr. Bradshaw stated that [RO-A18]'s parents were keen for the school to make a referral. This would be arranged by Duncan Eaton the newly appointed Head of Care.

[RO-A12] was to be reviewed on Thursday 27th June, he would arrange for a referral to be made to Mrs. Mellor.

Mrs. Cavanagh summing up noted that it was agreed :

- 1) Arrangements for Mrs. Mellor to interview [RO-A18] and [RO-A12] would be set up to take place as soon as possible.
