There needs to be long term monitoring by the LEA.

MAJOR ISSUES

1. The residential accommodation of the older pupils needs reviewing, single and double bedrooms are a priority.

2. There needs to be a general refurbishment of the whole school.

3. Equipment and Resources; there needs to be a resource audit.

and a resource policy

4. Staffing ; The numbers of staff are sufficient, but there needs to be training needs met on both sides, the teaching staff training needs should be prioritised.

5. Curriculum; The curriculum at the moment is impoverished, it does not meet the E.R.A. nor the requirements of the National Curriculum.

6. Teaching and Learning; There is a lack of differentiated work, and that is with 4 children in each group.

children's work

There is a lack of engagement, they were surprised how little the children actually did.

There is a lack of challenge.

Standards of work achieved were very low.

Standards of behaviour were variable, verbal aggression was often allowed to go on unchecked, the response needs to be consistent.

Some work is referred to the National Curriculum but only to Attainment Targets, that will narrow the Curriculum not widen it. Programmes of study need to be closely looked at.

There is no evidence of progression from one class to another, and continuity is not achieved, teaching staff are working in isolation.
