7? pupils from this unit were involved in homosexual activity and abuse on the Knowl View premises, including on the two recorded occasions when Mr R Hilton was allowed into the building by the boys.

The abuse took place over an extended period but seems to have culminated in September 1990 with two incidents mentioned above.

There is no evidence to suggest that boys from this unit participated in the homosexual activity at the Smith Street Toilets.

Staff who were on night supervision of these boys appeared:

either not to notice the behaviour of the boys
or not to communicate their observations.
