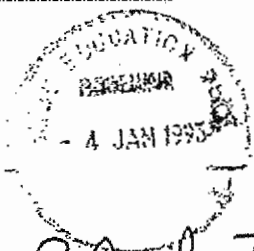

I write re Kowloon View School. In Surayan I saw that Mr Harry Wield 152 Allen Rd. is a good friend of mine. He's spoken to me 3 or 4 times during December about his deep concern and worry for the school, where he is now vice Chairman of Governors. Mr. Wield was a very senior manager for I.C.T. and has travelled the world on her behalf. He is also a former Maden Councillor. I value his judgement (for the former rather than latter reason!!!).

His view is that things are far from satisfactory at Kowloon View, and the wisest course would be to close the school and sell the land! I don't know about that - but I do know, an enquiry is called for, and if the LEA does not move - the danger is that others will - particularly National Assets etc.

I believe an enquiry is called for. I have read the confidential papers of the last 2 years at this school. We do not ignore the danger there. Mr Wield tells me he had a meeting with you, ~~that~~
