22.8.89

RO-A9 DPA Mother claims he is beyond her control and repeatedly appearing at Police Stations, staying out late, demanding her attention at the expense of her other children.

A report based on an interview with RO-A9 was prepared however since the DPA RO-B421 she has DPA Report altered

23.8.89

Mother attends clarification meeting with RO-A9 Father myself and Ian Lowery. DPA She restated her views of problems. Says she can no longer cope. RO-A9 admitted to DPA today. Mum present. Good admission by Peter.

25.8.89

Clarification meeting. I was not present due to sickness. Aims restated.

- 1) short term care until Sam restarts school - 3 weeks.
- 2) To return home thereafter for weekend leaves - further need to examine how care will be managed over this period.

28.8.89

Spoke to Peter at DPA RO-A9 spending little time there, some concern that he may be involving himself in prostitution - called 'rent boy' by other children.

Visited DPA spoke to Peter, earlier conversation with Danny Murphy and subsequent visit to Mother. Agreed that RO-A9 be discharged to Knowl View in my absence on leave. Subsequent discussion needed about our role in this behaviour. Mother reiterates that she wanted her son back it was DPA She also complained that her older son is also creating her problems - walked off with £10 yesterday - out all day returned 9.50 and 'got 1-4-10'. Not attending school - but currently on holiday. Asked that she attends herself at DPA to talk with Peter at least once or twice weekly. Messages passed from DPA and Mother by way of RO-A9 is not satisfactory.
