Phoned Peter Partridge about [RO-A10] and his recent behaviour at Rochdale toilets. This was discussed at the Cautioning Panel on Wed 26.8.92. Apparently he was importuning at the toilets with [RO-A9] [RO-A9]. The Police are charging a man involved who had taken them on on their offers but are unsure about what to do about [RO-A9] and [RO-A10], although they do not seem too concerned about pursuing the matter with [RO-A10] in any case. Apparently the panel put the matter back a week to allow Peter to get more information about [RO-A10] and [RO-A9]'s circumstances. I gave Peter some background about [RO-A10]'s time at [RO-A9] DPA and the reasons around his exclusion. Emphasised to him that [RO-A10] had done well since then to stay clear of trouble. He has made real efforts in this direction. Also emphasised that we were waiting on confirmation from the Education Dept about joint funding money for [RO-A10] and that Social Services on principle are prepared to fund [RO-A10]'s placement at St [RO-A10] Community School if the school will meet his identified needs. Peter will take this information back to the Cautioning Panel and get back to me next week about their decision.

[RO-A10] and [RO-A9] were with [RO-A24] when he was admitted to hospital. [RO-A10] Mother intends to go home at lunchtime to see if [RO-A24] has returned and if he hasn't she will report him missing to the Police.

They are investigating alternative placements (Local Authority) in other authorities and considering going to the Councillors to seek extra funding for [RO-A10]. I gave her a clear picture of [RO-A10]'s present situation and our responsibility to protect [RO-A10] and to educate him. I indicated that I would let our Area Manager know her news.
