had no specific involvement with any incident that may have occurred at the location. He was unable to assist the investigation.

Mr HENDERSON has been spoken to during the investigation and his account has been recorded. It features within this report under the subject heading 'Significant Multi-Agency Meetings' dated 8th March 1991.

On 26th May 2016, he was further interviewed regarding Smith Street toilets in which he said he was familiar with the location of Smith Street toilets but in his time as Detective Superintendent he did not supervise any initiatives at the toilets. He had heard them mentioned on the 'morning briefings' but only when, and for example, it was stated that someone had been arrested overnight for importuning and dealt with by the uniform officers.

It is clear from the examination of the aforementioned case files, and indeed interviews with police and Social Services staff involved at the time, that discussions regarding the problems at Smith Street toilets did take place. It is apparent also, that certain steps were being taken by both agencies; however because of police records for that period no longer being available, officer and staff recollections of events being limited due to the passage of time, and the reluctance of alleged victims to speak to the police and Social Services, there is only the reliance on local authority documents, which are limited and vague, as to individual case results for Smith Street toilets.

In the interim report produced by Neil GARNHAM QC for RMBC and made available to Operation CLIFTON he inserted the following entry.

The second book I found of great assistance was [RO-A29] the moving autobiographical work published in 2008 by [RO-A29] who had been a pupil at KVS in the 1970s. [RO-A29] was invited to provide me with his account of life at KVS personally and was kind enough to agree to be interviewed by telephone. His was the only detailed evidence I was able to obtain in relation to life at KVS in the early 1970s.

[RO-A29] provided an account of how the older boys at KVS would prostitute themselves at public lavatories in the town, best summarised by this excerpt of his book:
