

Paul Davis' comments.

Management Practices:

No way of preventing the incident - the building was large + had many entrances. It was not a secure unit. Waking Night Staff was not a solution.

Whole staff had not discussed the incident formally, but it had been discussed with Management Group of five (B Andrews, G Hutchinson, S. Oden, Paul Davis + Mrs Wheeler.)

Borgs given a good talking to + warned of the dangers of their action

Care Practice - to improve behaviour + conduct of boys.

- thinks single sex schools are an ~~anachronism~~ anachronism.

Noted relaxation of control at the school. - school trips formerly always controlled with boys under supervision - Boys now allowed to socialise more + to meet girls.

Need for counselling was noted - many pupils were very emotionally disturbed and sex was constantly on their mind

Staff Development: - Necessity was agreed. All course provided for all Care Staff. - Sex counselling covered by course.
