The issue was described as having his flies open when he was sitting on an organ stool when a young person was present.	No knowledge until she went through the blue file with David Charman Northants police in 2006/07.	

### Questions arising from above accounts:

+Wallace:

1. Did you know during the 98-99 investigations RC had a conviction?
2. How did you know at that time; who would have told you?
3. Did you see the blue file at that time or later?
4. Did +Eric tell you about RC's conviction?
5. Was it something that came up at the Snr Staff Meeting [with just the 3 bishops]
  
6. You said to me that you were aware of 'something' in RC's past, what was that?
7. Why was this info [either the matter from the past or the knowledge of a conviction] not passed on the CP Adviser?
  
8. Could the knowledge of RC's conviction have come much later? If so, when?
9. It seems like you had information about RC's past that made you feel that he was more likely to be guilty, hence the push for retirement.
10. Given that concern, why issue PTO?
