On Tuesday morning it was reported in the communications book that all staff should be very vigilant when locking up because Rod was back in the area.

On Thursday evening at 9.30pm Rod was seen with RO-A16 by Mr Davies outside Norden boot room door. Rod was told to leave the premises and RO-A16 to go back into the house unit. Rod kept returning to talk to RO-A16. On three separate incidents RO-A16 and Rod were confronted by Mr. Davies.

The police were informed of Rod and arrived in school but did not appear to be interested as Rod had not done any damage.

At 10.35 pm. RO-A28, RO-A15, RO-A18 and RO-A17 were all involved in talking to Rod and Rod told them to let him into school. At 11.15 pm. Rod arrived back into the grounds and climbed onto the kitchen roof hoping that RO-A16 would let him in. This incident was reported to Mr. Davies and Mr Found who eventually disposed of Rod. At 1.00 am. the school grounds were clear at 2.00 am. he was spotted in the woods but off the grounds.

Upon interviewing RO-A16 and RO-A15 it was discovered that Rod was around the building smoking with some of the Norden boys and was eventually allowed into the building by the boys on both Tuesday and Wednesday night to sleep under RO-A14's bed. RO-A14 knew this was happening and let Rod out early both mornings.

Rod has given? RO-A16 £1 and we believe that Rod will want his pound of flesh rather than a £1 coin,

18.9.90. Paul Davies contacted Rod's probation offices, Mr. Hanlon DPA. Apparently Rod is already in breach of his probation order and an attempt is being made to place him in Richmond Fellowship.

Rod is a schedule 1 offender under the 1933 children and young

persons act, because of this it was stated by Mr. Hanlon that it was not unreasonable for Rod to be kept away from premises where children are.

Mr. Hanlon is producing a document to the magistrates for Wednesday pm. 19.9.90. Stating that a condition of his probation is that he keeps out of Knowl View School grounds, If it does not go through on Wednesday it will sometime this week.

Mr. Hanlon will ring school when this new clause is placed but if school does not hear anything then Paul Davies will ring him. Rod Hilton is said to be back at home. G!!
