It was over a pretracted period and Dave can't remember chronology exactly.

It was useful to know info. in order to help with counselling for Bays which Dave used in various techniques and opportunities w/ social unacceptance and health risk feels BSP - as a care person and teacher that this should be part of his role.

Every day there was a communication book which teachers should read, info. was written in this, which Dave felt was adequate.
