[RO-A10] finds the pressure of dealing with unresolved issues difficult and as such, he needs support to help him deal with these matters. Bill agreed to do this.

18.5.90 ?

Visited [RO-A10] at Knowl View School. It appears there has been difficulty again between [Name Redacted] and [Redacted] and another resident which remains unresolved. As yet [RO-A10] has not apologised to Miss O'Connor over the previous incident and things are tense between Miss O'Connor and [RO-A10] at present. [RO-A10] apparently smoking in bed and as such came into conflict with Miss O'Connor.

Had a meeting between Miss O'Connor, [RO-A10], myself and Mr. Andrews who clearly stated the boundaries existing in the school. Agreed with Miss O'Connor that the unresolved matter occurring midweek would be dealt with between herself and Bill Roberts that afternoon.

24.5.90

Met with Paul Davies at Know View regarding recent incidents relating to [RO-A10]. Apparently on Monday [RO-A10] together with [RO-A12] and another Knowl View resident, ran off, having got up very early in the morning. They met up with [RO-A9] in town from whence they went to the Bus Station to ask people for money and later they went to the toilets in Smith Street. Apparently the boys say that [RO-A12] masturbated a man while in the toilets. Apparently [RO-A10] also did this as did [RO-A9]. It would seem that each of them got money for this. Later on that day [RO-A10] and [RO-A9] apparently stole a handbag which had money and credit cards in it. They apparently kept the money and hid the purse near the Citizens' Advice Bureau. They spent the money on food in McDonalds and Tasty Bite and going on a trip to Oldham. They apparently got spotted on Monday night by a Knowl View pupil. They were taken to the Police Station and then Knowl View. They were apparently filthy. They admitted all these matters to the police.

Apparently there was also some suggestion that they are involved in mugging young Asian kids in Rochdale. [RO-A12] apparently told the police about the toilet incidents etc. which [RO-A10] and [RO-A9] eventually admitted to. The police intend to continue investigation of the toilet incidents re [RO-A10] and [RO-A9] in the hope of catching the men who are involved.

[RO-A10] admits that he was involved in these sexual activities on Monday and on previous occasions when he ran off to Dunkirk Rise flats recently and before that. Police are coming today to interview [RO-A10] in more detail about these incidents.

Later on, talked with [RO-A10] about the incidents in the presence of Paul Davies. He was very quiet and withdrawn and concerned about this matter being brought up again. We acknowledged that these events had occurred, acknowledged that the men involved bore the blame for what had
