



INDEPENDENT INQUIRY CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

CHANGE IN RECOGNISED LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE

1. On 24 July 2017, I designated D49 as a core participant in the Inquiry's investigation into the extent of any institutional failures to protect children in the care of the Nottinghamshire Councils from sexual abuse and exploitation. At the same time, I designated Debbie Heath of Bhatia Best solicitors as his recognised legal representative.
2. On 9 July 2018, the Inquiry was informed that D49 wished to change his legal representation from Bhatia Best solicitors to Kim Harrison of Slater & Gordon solicitors. As a result of this change in legal representative, the Inquiry will now refer to this individual as A78 in the Inquiry's proceedings.
3. Accordingly, as I am satisfied that A78 has now appointed Kim Harrison of Slater & Gordon solicitors as his qualified lawyer, I designate Ms Harrison as his recognised legal representative in this investigation in accordance with rule 6(1) Inquiry Rules 2006 as I am required by that rule to do.
