Jane,

I send this email to inform you that **I will not be appearing in court.**

It is clear to me that the CPS are dragging their feet because of P Ball's connections and his former status, although you can dress it up as legal complications. I suspect he will be let off, again. I have once before "stuck my neck above the parapet" and writing my statement for you took some courage, since I am aware that it has already damaged me.

This has gone on too long. It has put enormous strain on me, and it is not fair. My current circumstances mean I am withdrawing.

If I have contravened some law, so be it. Others, who are not in my circumstances can take the strain. In 1992 I did it alone, and no one was there to help me then. In fact the Establishment (including the Police) just effectively dismissed the incident(s). The only reason yourselves and others are bothered now is because of the scandal of the Roman Catholic Church and the Jimmy Saville history. I did something when it was not fashionable, and there was no help - at all.

I have done my bit. That's it. End.

You can contact me to acknowledge this email, but beyond that I wish for no further contact. I look forward to seeing "British Justice" collude on my TV.

Dear **AN-A99**

As you are aware from our previous update, Operation Dunhill has been a lengthy and complicated process, and has taken longer than we originally anticipated to reach a decision regarding the outcome. We are aware that this has been difficult for some people, and are very grateful for your patience and understanding in this matter. We do not under-estimate how difficult this has been for some of you.

You may or may not be aware that Operation Dunhill is an investigation into two suspects, Bishop Peter Ball and Rev Vickery House. CPS have been considering the allegations made regarding both suspects, and have authorised 8 charges against Vickery House, who was charged today and will appear at court on 27th February 2014. He has been released on bail until that date.

The case against Bishop Peter Ball has some further complex legal issues, which are being considered by the Principal Legal Advisor at the CPS. They have not yet reached a decision regarding those allegations, however that piece of work is a priority, and we anticipate their advice in the near future. All parties involved are aware of the need for a decision to be reached in this matter as soon as possible. You will be updated as soon as we have received that advice.
