NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

CHANGE IN RECOGNISED LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE

1. On 11 October 2017, 13 February 2018 and 31 May 2018, I designated Ofsted as a core participant in each of the following investigations: investigation into the extent of any institutional failures to protect children from sexual abuse within the Roman Catholic Church in England and Wales; investigation into the extent of any institutional failures to protect children from sexual abuse and exploitation while in custodial institutions; investigation into the extent of any institutional failures to protect children in the care of Nottingham City and Nottinghamshire Councils from sexual abuse and exploitation. At the same time, I designated Sandra Walker of Ofsted Legal Services as Ofsted's recognised legal representative.
2. On 22 July 2018, the Inquiry was informed that Ms Walker would be leaving Ofsted and that James Fawcett would be acting as Ofsted's legal representative in relation to the above investigations.
3. Accordingly, as I am satisfied that Ofsted has now appointed James Fawcett of Ofsted Legal Services as its qualified lawyer, I designate Mr Fawcett as its recognised legal representative in the above investigations in accordance with Rule 6(1) of the Inquiry Rules 2006 as I am required by that rule to do.
