I have had several telephone calls from the Solicitors who represent the Bishop, who are Messrs Madge, Lloyd and Gibson, of Gloucester.

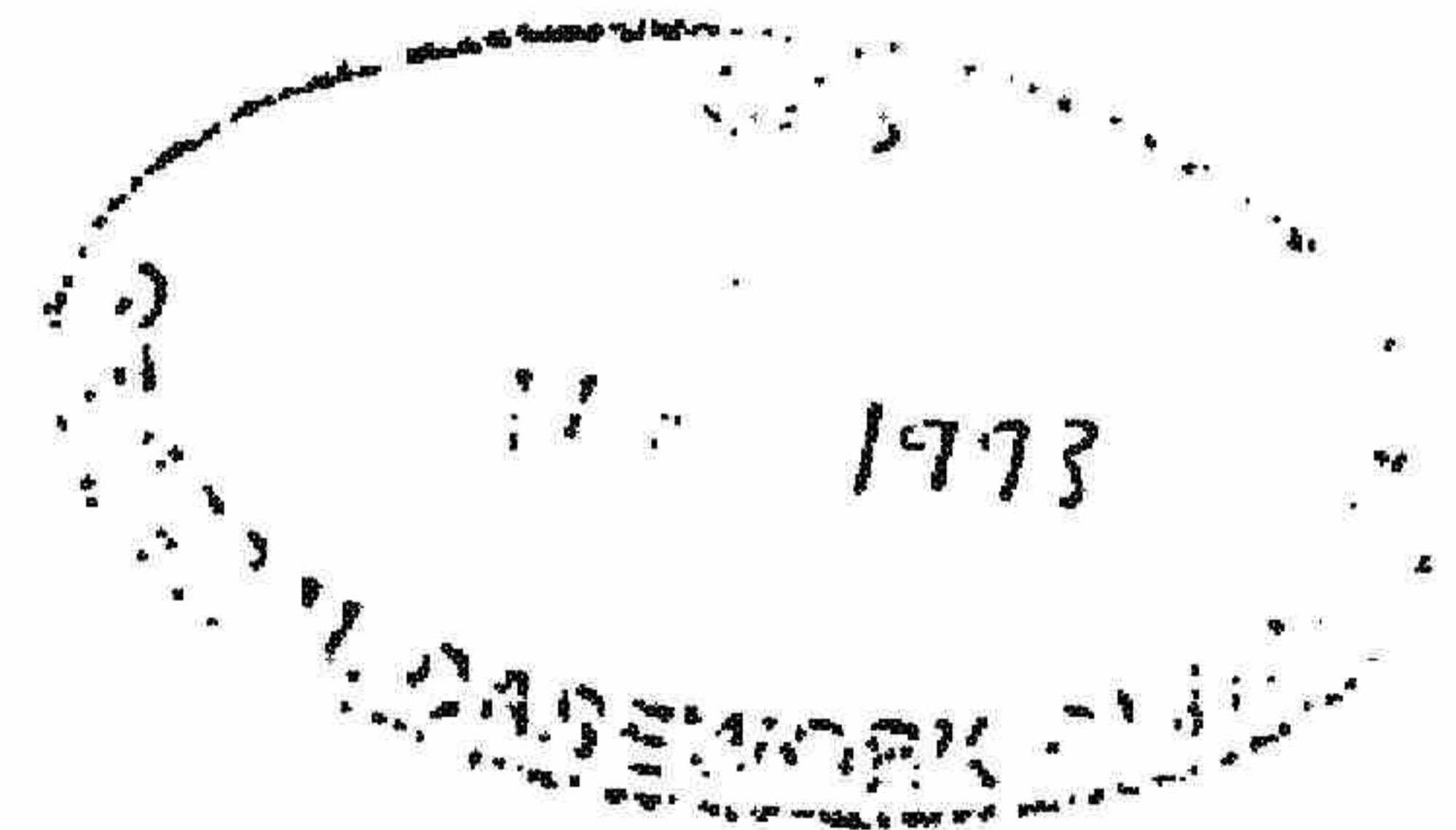
They have repeatedly told me that the Bishop has signed a deed in escrow resigning from his post as a Diocesan Bishop and they have irrevocable instructions in writing that, if he is cautioned, the deed is to be put into effect.
